Euclid Symphony Orchestra Indoor Rehearsal Policy as of 9/3/2021

Orchestra members will follow the CDC guidelines to reduce spread of Covid19/Delta Variant while rehearsing inside with the Euclid Symphony Orchestra. They are as follows:

- 1. All members must be fully vaccinated in order to participate in rehearsals or concerts. Proof of vaccination status is required. Please bring in your cards to show Rachel (or another board member if Rachel is not present).
- 2. Universal Masking.
 - a. All members will mask during rehearsal with the exception of wind players during playing times. Wind players are expected to mask any time they are not actively playing (eg. during breaks, long rests, whenever Matt is working with another group of musicians, etc.)
 - Brass instruments will use absorbent pads to collect condensation. ESO will supply puppy pads to each player.
- 3. Maintain Social distancing of 6 ft, when possible.
- 4. Follow CDC guidelines for Covid-19 exposure:

"If you've had close contact with someone who has COVID-19, you should get tested 3-5 days after your exposure, even if you don't have symptoms. You should also wear a mask indoors in public for 14 days following exposure or until your test result is negative. You should isolate for 10 days if your test result is positive."

5. Self-report symptoms to Rachel, follow CDC recommendations for quarantine/isolation, and abstain from attending rehearsal if found to be Covid positive. Reporting can be sent to euclidorchestra@gmail.com or (216) 570-7139 (Rachel's cell).
